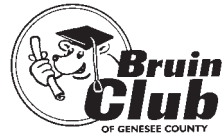


Keynote Address: **The Honorable Tabitha Marsh**

Judge Tabitha Marsh was elected to the 67th District Court in November 2020, representing the City of Flint. She is currently the only female serving on the Flint District Court, and the only African American female serving on the Genesee County District Court. Judge Marsh is also a licensed minister and a member of Embassy Covenant Church International. At Embassy Covenant Church Judge Marsh has served in various positions and is currently a member of the Church’s Presbytery Board, Prophetic Department and Ministerial Team.

She earned a bachelor’s degree in business from the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor. She earned a Juris Doctorate in 2004 from Michigan State University College of Law.
